You will start with the [Core Construction certification](#) that prepares individuals for positions on project sites by providing the basics in safety, hand and power tools, construction math, materials handling, construction drawings, rigging, and employability skills.

The [Drywall Installer Certification](#) (levels 1 & 2) validates a learner's knowledge, skill, and ability to perform in-office and fieldwork duties efficiently, accurately, and safely. The Drywall Installer training has two levels to ensure learners fully understand drywall installation and finishing, including wall and ceiling installation and placing insulation, soundproofing, and fire-stopping materials. The curriculum also covers applying internal and exterior textures and trims. This curriculum complies with the U.S. Department of Labor's standards for Drywall Applicator apprenticeship programs.

Earn Three Certificates

Receive certifications employers are looking for. Upon completion of the program, individuals will receive 3 certificates, including certificates stating learners completed the following:

1. Core Construction training.
2. Drywall Installation training.
3. Three courses valued at 3 credit hours each (i.e., 9 credits), including (a) Business Communications, (b) Computer Skills for the Workplace, and (c) Financial Literacy.
4. The course codes are BCOMM001, COMP001, FINA001 respectively.
